



What LO's are

 - ☐ A chance to work/read with people you may not otherwise work with.
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



The Roles

- ❑ Discussion Director
 - ❑ Friend of the Character
 - ❑ Word Finder
 - ❑ Connector
 - ❑ Illustrator
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


Discussion Director

- ❓ Asks questions about the novel:
 - ❓ Why is it outer space?
 - ❓ What would it be like to be lost in the woods?
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Friend of the Character


- ❓ Asks questions as if you were the best friend of the main character - almost in the novel, but not really.
 - ❓ Do you think 'he' likes 'her'?
 - ❓ Do you think they are scared being locked in that haunted house?
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Word Finder

 Finds neat, unique, or strange words in the reading:

 What does ultralite mean?




 Why did the author use the word 'ultra-cool'?

Connector

- This person finds connections between the book and 'your' real life:
 - Would you have gone into the spooky house?
 - Have you ever ridden a horse?
 - Have you ever lived with your grandma

 This person draws a picture about what was read.
